**1** **78% of Americans** *are concerned or very concerned* that supply chains would be significantly disrupted if there was an armed conflict between China and Taiwan.

PARTY BREAKDOWN: **81% of** REPUBLICANS **80% of** DEMOCRATS **76% of** INDEPENDENTS

**2** **73% of Americans** *support or strongly support* legislation that stops foreign countries that the U.S. considers to be adversaries or national security threats, such as China, from supplying key parts of their state's critical infrastructure.

PARTY BREAKDOWN: **82% of** REPUBLICANS **74% of** DEMOCRATS **70% of** INDEPENDENTS

**3** **80% of Americans** *support or strongly support* legislation that requires American companies to remove Chinese telecommunications equipment.

PARTY BREAKDOWN: **86% of** REPUBLICANS **76% of** DEMOCRATS **82% of** INDEPENDENTS

**4** **79% of Americans** *support or strongly support* legislation that stops companies from foreign countries that are considered a national security threat, such as China, from bidding on state or local contracts for projects or supplies.

PARTY BREAKDOWN: **85% of** REPUBLICANS **77% of** DEMOCRATS **78% of** INDEPENDENTS

**5** **76% of Americans** *are concerned or very concerned* that state or local pension funds are being invested in companies and other entities that support competitors and countries that the U.S. considers to be adversaries, such as China.

PARTY BREAKDOWN: **84% of** REPUBLICANS **75% of** DEMOCRATS **71% of** INDEPENDENTS

**6** **69% of Americans** *would likely buy* an American-made product if they were shopping and found two identical products, one made in America, and one made in China.

PARTY BREAKDOWN: **83% of** REPUBLICANS **70% of** DEMOCRATS **63% of** INDEPENDENTS

**7** **71% of Americans** *would pay between 5% and 25% more* for goods that are manufactured in the United States or an allied nation rather than China.

PARTY BREAKDOWN: **81% of** REPUBLICANS **70% of** DEMOCRATS **67% of** INDEPENDENTS

**8** **82% of Americans** *support or strongly support* their state government paying more to purchase products manufactured by America and its allies, rather than products from China.

PARTY BREAKDOWN: **90% of** REPUBLICANS **82% of** DEMOCRATS **77% of** INDEPENDENTS

**9** **68% of Americans** *support or strongly support* legislation that stops schools from accepting gifts or contracts, or academic partnerships from countries of concern like China.

PARTY BREAKDOWN: **80% of** REPUBLICANS **67% of** DEMOCRATS **62% of** INDEPENDENTS

**10** **70% of Americans** *support or strongly support* legislation that stops all public investments, such as pension funds or university endowments, from investing in the assets of foreign countries the U.S. considers to be adversaries such as China or Iran.
